

For Sale 1983 Mercedes Benz W123 280CE (gas motor!) Coupe w/ 4 speed manual 148,000 miles - Drives like new, needs nothing. Asking \$27,000

Very original, no accidents, German delivered, highly optioned W123 inline-6 gas motor (189 hp), with original 4-speed manual and correct gauge cluster with tachometer. The Astral Silver exterior shines and stands out with the original German bumpers, German headlights, and even headlight wipers! The paint, chrome, and trim are in excellent condition except for a few small blemishes, one on the hood, the drivers

side B pillar, and the drivers side front fender. The original weather stripping is showing its age, but still keeps the car weathertight and the doors close perfectly with that satisfying Mercedes sound! It's clear the car has never been apart.

The original blue dash is perfect, unfaded, with no cracks, the wood is glossy with no cracks and the cloth seats and door cards have no rips, tears, stains. Power sunroof, power front windows, air conditioning all work perfectly. The AC was converted to R134 in 2022 under my ownership by a high quality local shop (receipts available). Even the luggage shelf shows no signs of UV fade and the medical kit is a genuine kit purchased in 1991. All of the gauges and buttons work as intended, including the additional gauges added sometime in the 80's or 90's. The coco mats are brand new and I have the original blue mats which are in excellent condition. The spare tire shows no signs of being disturbed since its factory installation in 1983 and is marked made in "West Germany."

All belts, tires, and shifter bushings replaced in 2022; plus a fresh oil change and brake bleed in October 2023, result in a well sorted car capable of being driven anywhere in true Mercedes comfort including at highway speeds. If the new owner wishes, the car has been accepted into an exhibit at the Forney Automotive Museum this winter. The invitation can be extended to the new owner if desired.

In 1983, Mercedes produced only 2,237 280CE coupes for the European market only, none were sold in the US. Only 10-15% were equipped with the 4-speed manual. Additionally, this was delivered in Germany and I presume imported to the US before 1988 by Orient - Krone. The first aid kit has the Mercedes dealership part number sticker dated from 1991, and under the seat, I found an Aspen parking pass from 1999 proving the car's early importation. I have the original blue mats not shown in the photos.
